- **Project Title:** *“India-EU co-operation on ICT-related standardisation, policy and legislation”*
- **Pilot Phase:** April 2015 – March 2016
- **Implementation Phase:** November 2016 - October 2019

Project Objective

- Promote closer alignment between India and Europe with regard to the production and use of global ICT standards
- Improve ease of doing business (interoperability)
- Add additional weight to European and Indian ICT standardisation efforts at global level
- + Harmonise exchange of statistical data (SDMX)

Main Cooperation Partners

- European Telecommunications Standards Institute (ETSI)
- Telecommunications Standards Development Society, India (TSDSI)
- Department of Telecommunications (DoT), C-DOT, Telecom Centres of Excellence (TCoE), Cellular Operators Association of India (COAI), IISc, ...
