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Indo-EU collaboration for ICT Standardization

- Data & AI

- India is examining the issues related to the scope of regulation and legislation for data protection e.g. personal data/ non-personal data, data localization, government access etc.
- Aside from Consumer data, M2M data and M2M Security is a priority for India. Data, Security and Privacy present massive opportunities for standardization and promoting global standards
- The identification and certification of M2M Devices are particularly important. The TRAI has recommended the set up of a National Trust Centre for IoT Devices and Applications, and the DoT has passed on the baton to the Telecom Engineering Centre (TEC) for implementation
- The next phase may consider an Indo-EU cooperation to develop a pilot for a globally extensible and inter-operable framework for bilateral recognition of the certification (MTCTE) processes and an online mechanism for identifying and verifying certified devices and apps
- Such a pilot could leverage and put into practical use, OneM2M framework of registries, ETSI's bootstrapping framework, ETSI's NGSI-LD/ Context Information Management and India's IUDX initiatives for public data sharing and M2M Profiles/ Data management
